Proposal Abstract: Native Healing Ways

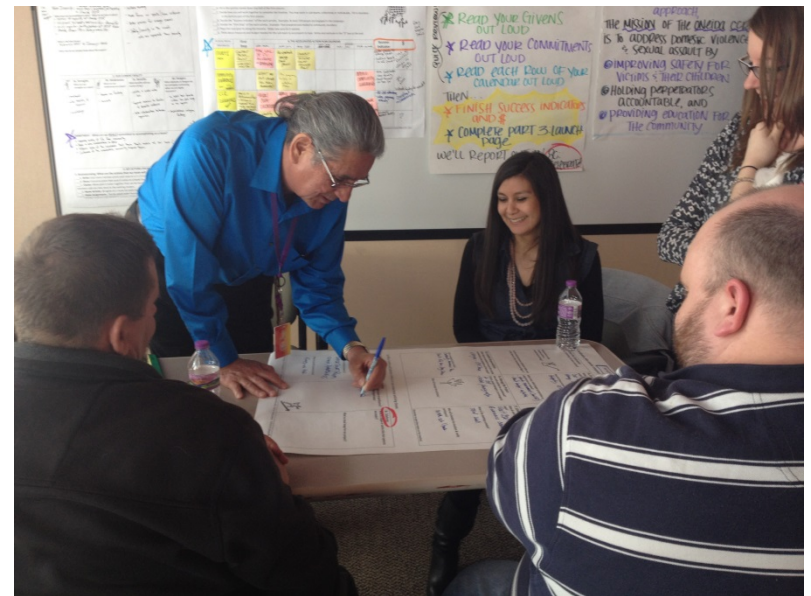
Wise Women Gathering Place (WWGP) enhances culturally specific capacity for crisis sexual assault response for the Native American victims in Oneida Nation and Greater Green Bay areas of Wisconsin.

Native Healing Ways

- WWGP will hire an additional Domestic Violence/Sexual Assault Program Specialist to provide crisis response to victims of sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking, as well as homeless victims on the Native American New Hope transitional housing wait list, to meet the rising need.
- Services to support victims in crisis and healing include Emergency shelter, emergency funds, transportation assistance and registration for White Bison: Mending Broken Hearts - Unresolved Grief and Inter-Generational Trauma.

Objectives

Revitalize Oneida Coordinated Community Response Team (OCCR) to develop and enhance effective collaborative efforts to provide culturally specific service to victims of sexual assault, domestic/dating violence and stalking



Objectives

Provide Native American culturally specific resources and services that address safety, economic, housing, workplace needs and emergency assistance of victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, dating violence and stalking, including people on the Transitional Living Program Waitlist.



Objectives

Enhance the traditional domestic violence services of CCR member agencies with Native American culturally specific training through White Bison Train the Trainer, and Discovery Dating Facilitator trainings
